LOCAL TRAIN FARES 1909 (published in 'The Friend' 9 July 1909)

Travelling facilities have been much extended in recent years. A good service of fast trains runs to the City. The season ticket to King's Cross is £8 8s 0d Second, and £7 3s 0d Third class and to Moorgate Street or Broad Street at option £11 second, £9 third. This service is supplemented by connection with Tube railways at Finsbury Park, which places one within easy reach of any part of the City or West End.

The district and poor rates amount to 7s 6d in the £. Six postal deliveries and 9 collections are provided.
